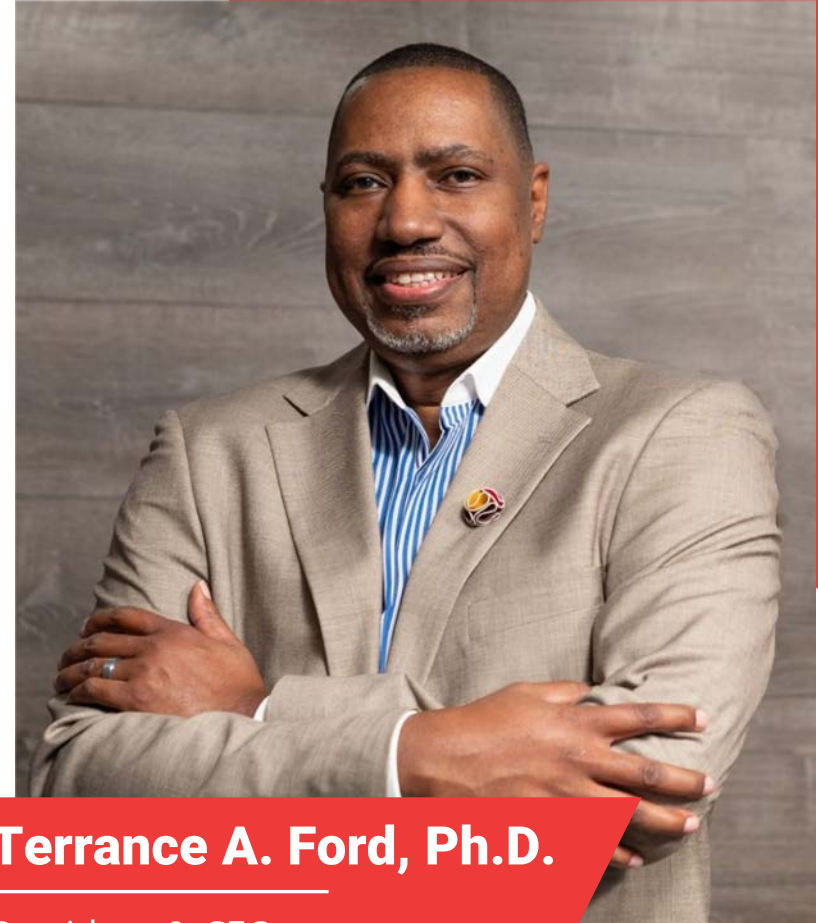

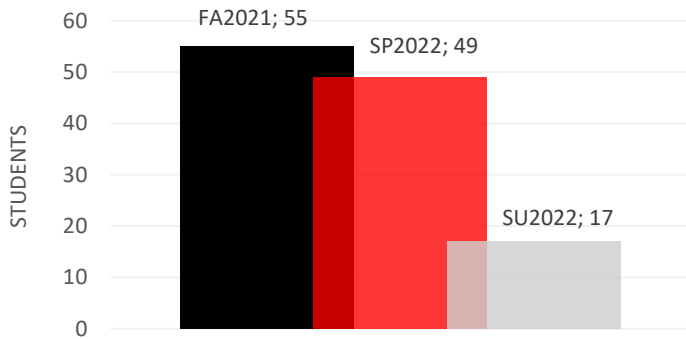

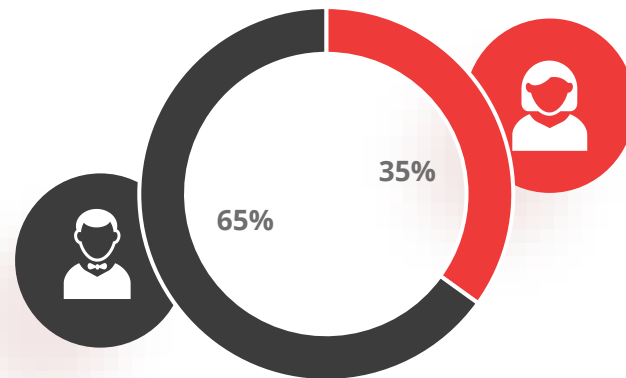
Statistics (by the Numbers)

Enrollment by Semester

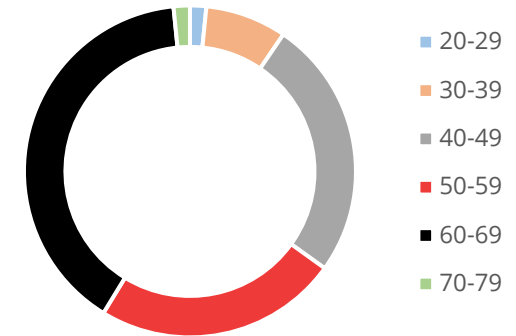

Students by Sex

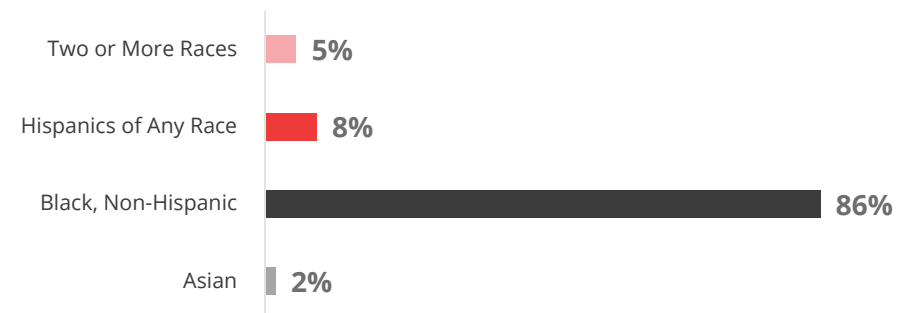


Students by Age Range



Average Age **55**

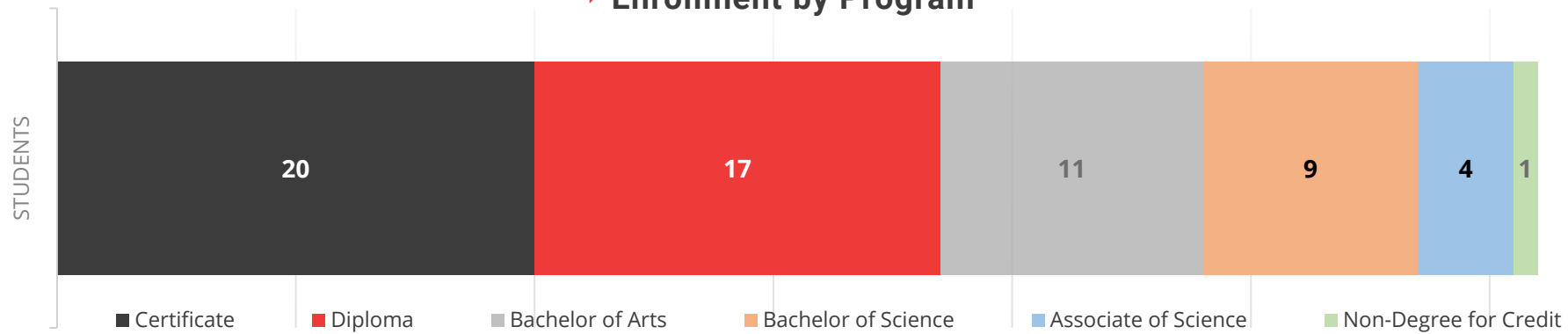
Students by Ethnicity



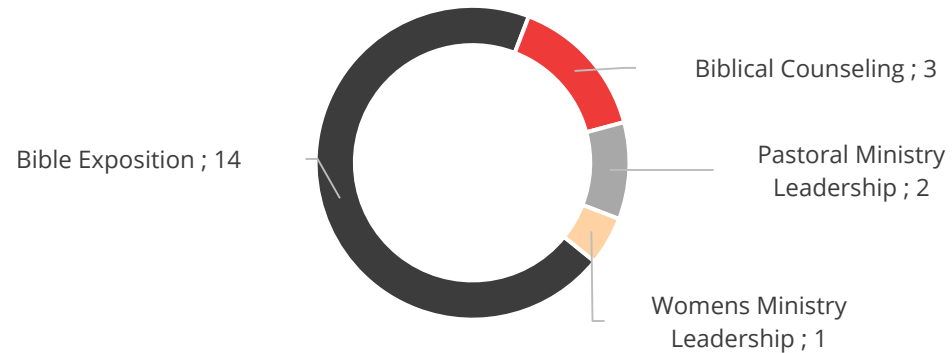

Enrollment by Program

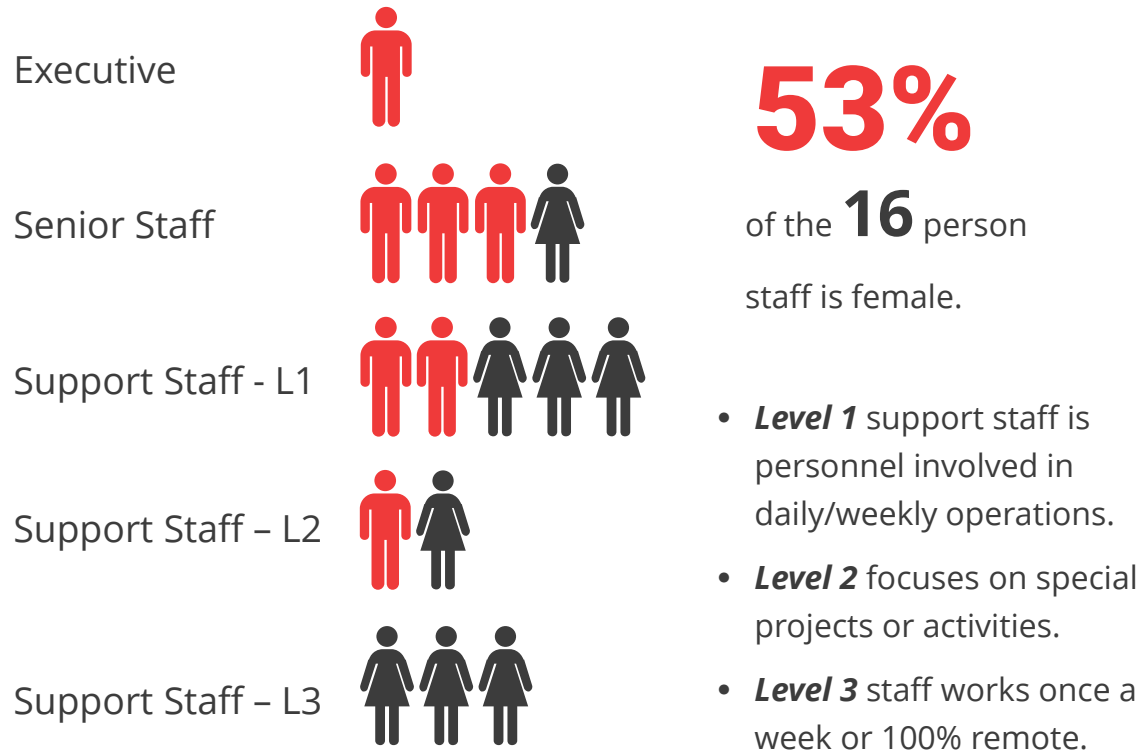


Certificate Programs Breakdown



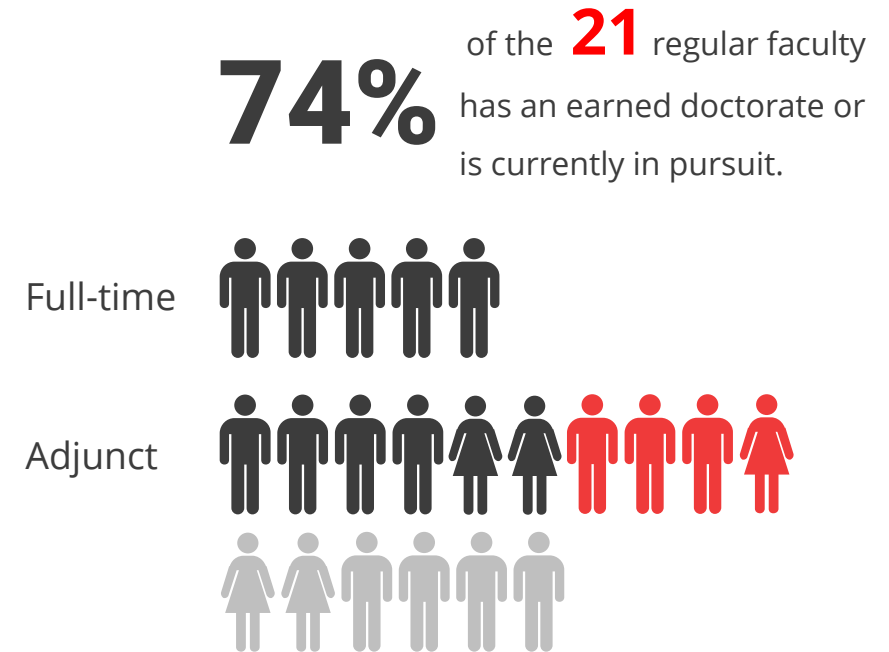

Faculty by Count, Credentials, & Demographics

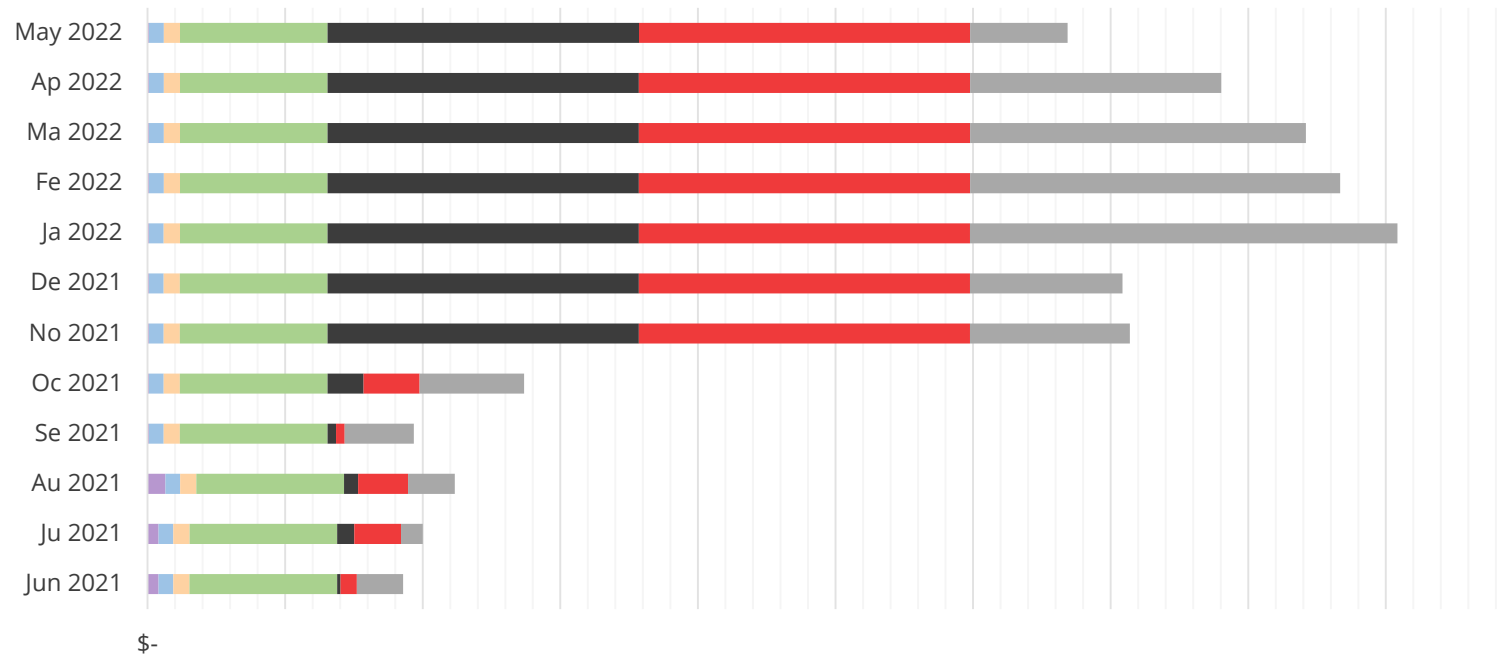

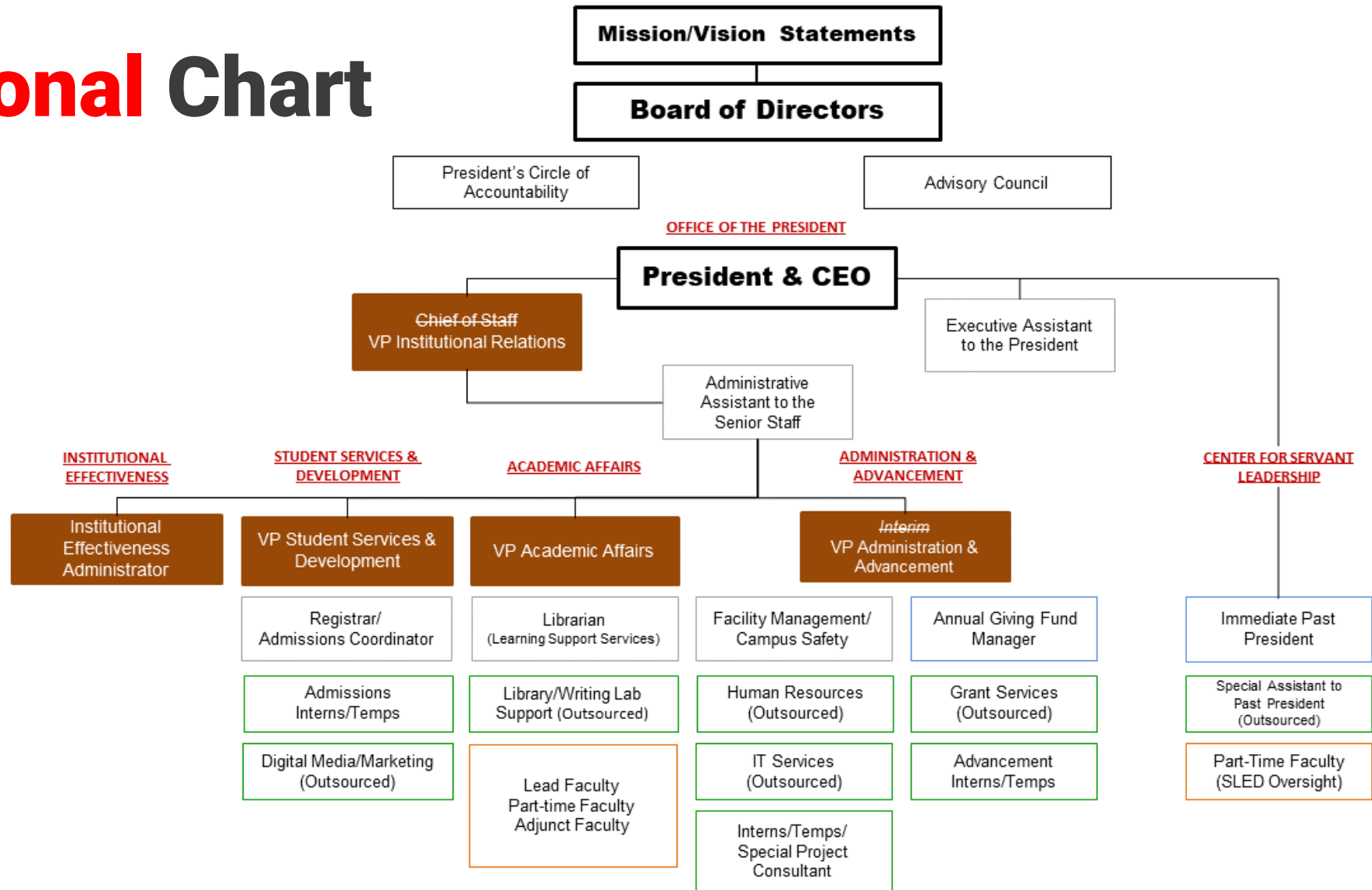

Strategic Initiatives/Goals

Preparation for Beyond Accreditation

Daniel Scholars Program

This program helps equip more traditional students 18 - 25 (males and females), while growing our AA degree program. Students are mentored, less burdened financially, and better prepared for upper level college rigor after completing their first two years of college.

Hyflex Distant Education

This online course delivery model not only allows distant students to receive a quality and engaging SBIC education, but accommodates students with busy/fluctuating work/life schedules as well.





Center for Servant Leadership

The Center will promote and provide Bible-centered servant leadership efforts between the College, the community, and the local church. It serves to fulfill our commitment to bridging academia and frontline hands-on ministry.

Church Planting & Revitalization Tracks

A reinvigoration of the Pastoral Ministry Leadership program will now include concentration options for church planting and church revitalization. These revisions are being enacted in cooperation with several church planting/revitalization organizations.

Title IV Funding Eligibility

Final training requirements for Title IV eligibility are underway. Plans for application submission and approval are anticipated to be fulfilled by fall 2024.

Centennial Capital Campaign
